DECLARATION

I declare that during the Rally my exhibit (whether self-propelled or not self-propelled) will be covered by a Public Liability Policy including Event use, and by a Boiler Explosion Policy, where appropriate, both policies having a limit of indemnity of not less than £2,000,000 in any one accident, and Sparks and Ashes cover for not less than £100,000. I further declare that the boiler of any steam plant entered carries a current Boiler Inspection Certificate and that I will produce documentary evidence of such Insurance and Inspection to you before participating in the Rally. During the Rally, I declare that my exhibit will be covered by the minimum insurance requirements of the Road Traffic Act irrespective of whether my exhibit is licensed for use on the Public Highway or not. I understand that any exhibitor found to be operating any equipment under the influence of alcohol or drugs will be asked to leave the site. I further declare that the driver(s)/rider(s) of any exhibit not excluded from use on the public highway, holds a driving license of the appropriate class for that exhibit. I agree to produce the insurance and license documents to the Rally Organiser or Safety Officer if requested. I agree to abide by the Code of Practice of the National Traction Engine Trust and the Rally Committee's written Statement of Safety Policy. I agree to operate my exhibit during the Rally and comply with the instructions of stewards. In the event of a dispute the Rally Organisers' decision is final. I understand that the Rally Organisers cannot accept any claim for damage or personal injury sustained whilst taking part in the Rally or travelling to or from the Rally. I will abide by the rules and guidelines detailed overleaf.

RALLY INFORMATION & GUIDELINES

As you are all aware our aim is to provide a friendly, safe and enjoyable Rally – please make sure you read and comply with the Guidelines For insurance purposes it is important that we receive the signed Entry Form.

Passes

Each Exhibitor will be issued passes allowing entry for TWO ADULTS and TWO CHILDREN under 16 years of age. EVERY OTHER PERSON WILL BE CHARGED THE FULL ENTRANCE FEE.

Please note our objective is to raise money for charities and our admission prices are extremely modest. Our aim is to ensure that all those who have a definite need for a Pass are catered for, whilst for the enjoyment of all concerned, we do not want to have any more vehicles on site than is necessary. There is ample free parking adjacent to the Rally Field.

One attendant vehicle per exhibitor only. If you bring a caravan the tow car must be parked off site.

Safety

All exhibitors are reminded that they are responsible for their own insurance cover. Exhibitors should have copies of the relevant insurance certificates available for inspection on site.

Being an NTET approved Rally, we ask that all Steam Engines arrive on site with current NTET discs fitted and displayed (or Form 55 Boiler Certificate, Boiler Explosion and Road Traffic Act Insurance Certificate form available). All numbers will be recorded and included in the Rally report. Minature & Model engines should produce proof of insurance if discs are not available.

In the interest of safety, no unauthorised driving around the site will be permitted at any time. Please DO NOT ALLOW CHILDREN TO DRIVE on the site. SAC APPRENTICES under 21 years of age must be accompanied by owner/qualified adult.

The minimum age for drivers to drive on the rally site which is deemed a public place must be at least 16 years of age (for tractors) if they have passed a test otherwise at least 17 years of age (and have passed an appropriate test).

Please note that the Rally site is governed by the laws that apply to normal public roads including driving a vehicle or operating machinery while under the influence of alcohol or drugs.

Any passengers on vehicles should be on a proper seat

Please move around the site slowly and with due regard to visitors.

Do not remove any safety barrier, rope or guard and stay well clear of the ring entrance and exits.

If you see anything that common sense tells you is unsafe, report it to a Marshall, Committee member or the organiser's office at the Main Gate. Always take due care and attention to safety to make the Rally enjoyable for all. **DON'T WALK BY!**

Please keep dogs on a lead always.

Overhead Electrical Cables - Considerations and Precautions

Overview - It has been noted that the areas the Heddington and Stockley Steam fair operate in have a number of 11Kv and 33Kv overhead power lines. Whilst these are not considered a significant risk in the spirit of continual improvement and improving safety wherever possible a number of minor changes have been discussed and agreed to increase volunteer, exhibitor and public safety. These changes include:

- not erecting any aerial, flagpole or temporary structure if a Marshall or Steward explicitly requests that you do not.
- not moving your vehicle once you have been given an area to locate in. If you need to move, contact a marshal for advice.
- not interfering with or moving barriers erected for your safety.

General

Payment, to all entitled to payment, will be made from 4pm onwards on Sunday 5th July 2026. Exhibitors leaving before that time will not be paid, as members of the public will still be paying to enter the Rally.

THE ENTRANCE GATE IS MANNED FROM 9AM TO 10PM ON FRIDAY & FROM 8AM ON SATURDAY AND SUNDAY. The public start coming through the gates at 9 am on Saturday morning, we know it is not possible for everyone to be on site by this time, but we must insist that you arrive no later than 10am. PLEASE ENSURE THAT YOU ARRIVE BY THIS TIME OR WE MAY HAVE TO REFUSE ENTRY. Ring events start at 10.45 on Saturday and 10.30 on Sunday. Exhibitors are required to show their mobile exhibits in the ring for the public's enjoyment.

Please enclose 2 LARGE A5 STAMPED, self-addressed envelope for your free passes and next year's forms. Please make sure you put the correct postage stamp on your entry as well as the SAE, otherwise the Post Office will not deliver. We will not collect post with insufficient postage stamps.

The closing date for entries to be included within the programme is 30th April. We will accept entries after this date if space allows, however our Rally is very popular, and spaces are allocated on a "first come first served" basis so PLEASE return your entry forms in good time to ensure acceptance!

Remember to fill in your ATTENDANCE days and CAMPING requirements and the all-important signing of the form. Camping may not be next to your exhibit.

The movement of vehicles on the field is another safety issue, at the last Rally there appeared to be a constant movement of vehicles in and out of the Rally field, no casual or unplanned vehicle movements or rides around the site on exhibits are permitted at any time. Leaving early or popping out for half an hour is unacceptable. ONLY ESSENTIAL MOVEMENT PLEASE.

Passes are sent out at the beginning of June
