RALLY INFORMATION & GUIDELINES

Passes

Please note our objective is to raise money for charities and our admission prices are extremely modest. Our aim is to ensure that all those who have a definite need for a Site Vehicle Pass are catered for, whilst for the enjoyment of all concerned, we do not want to have any more vehicles on site than is absolutely necessary. There is ample free parking adjacent to the Rally Field.

This pass will only be valid if the vehicle registration number is written on the pass and the pass is in full view on the dashboard of the vehicle. Any vehicle not displaying a valid pass will be directed to the Public Car Parks.

One attendant vehicle per Craft Entrant only.

Safety

All Craft Entrants are reminded that they are responsible for their own Public Liability insurance cover. This may be checked at anytime and must be provided.

In the interest of safety, no unauthorised driving around the site will be permitted at any time. Please **DO NOT ALLOW CHILDREN TO DRIVE** on the site.

Any passengers on vehicles should be on a proper seat.

Please move around the site slowly and with due regard to visitors.

Do not remove any safety rope or guard and in particular stay well clear of the ring entrance and exits.

If you see anything that common sense tells you is unsafe, report it to a Committee member or the organiser's tent.

Always take due care and attention to safety in order to make the Rally enjoyable for all.

Please keep **DOGS ON A LEAD** at all times.

Overhead Electrical Cables - Considerations and Precautions

Overview - It has been noted that the areas the Heddington and Stockley Steam fair operate in have a number of 11Kv and 33Kv overhead power lines. Whilst these are not considered a significant risk in the spirit of continual improvement and improving safety wherever possible a number of minor changes have been discussed and agreed to increase volunteer, exhibitor and public safety. These changes include:

- not erecting any aerial, flagpole or temporary structure if a Marshall or Steward explicitly requests that you do not.
- not moving your vehicle once you have been given an area to locate in, if you need to move contact a marshal for advice.
- not interfering with or moving barriers erected for your safety.

General

The Entrance Gate to the Rally Site will be manned from 9.00am to 10pm on Friday 3rd July and from 8.00am on Saturday and on Sunday 4th & 5th July. There will be no exceptions to this.
