In the interest of Health & Safety If your stall or gazebo requires guy ropes to secure it to the ground, please include additional space for this also.

No trader will be permitted to place exhibits, displays, signage boards, tables or any other item or projecting structure beyond the limits of his/her allocated site in any direction. Please note that this is to ensure all emergency routes/thoroughfares are kept clear for vehicles in the event of an emergency.

If you trade as a market stall, please allow yourself enough room to walk around to the front of your stall.

Any additional space required on the day will be charged at £ 20.00 per metre (minimum of one metre).

Please ensure you have a suitable fire extinguisher.

The allocation of a pitch/site shall be strictly on a first come, first served basis at the sole discretion of the organiser, however, every endeavour will be made to allocate fair trading site. Once positioned no changes will be permitted.

A trader is free to pack up and leave the event at any time (whilst escorted) but may not return.

There will not be any sale of refreshments, food or drinks other than by PRIOR authorisation from the organisers. Also, there will not be any sale of goods, substances, materials or weapons banned or licensed by law.

Please drive carefully on the site following the Highway Code and obey instructions from the volunteer marshals.

## RALLY INFORMATION & GUIDELINES

### Passes

Please note our objective is to raise money for charities and our admission prices are extremely modest. Our aim is to ensure that all those who have a definite need for a Site Vehicle Pass are catered for, whilst for the enjoyment of all concerned, we do not want to have any more vehicles on site than is absolutely necessary. There is ample free parking adjacent to the Rally Field.

This pass will only be valid if the vehicle registration number is written on the pass and the pass is in full view on the dashboard of the vehicle. Any vehicle not displaying a valid pass will be directed to the Public Car Parks.

One attendant vehicle per Trade Entrant only.

### Safety

Trade Entrants are reminded that they are responsible for their own Public Liability insurance cover. This may be checked at any time and must be provided.

In the interest of safety, no unauthorised driving around the site will be permitted at any time. Please DO NOT ALLOW CHILDREN TO DRIVE on the site.

Any passengers on vehicles should be on a proper seat.

Please move around the site slowly and with due regard to visitors.

Do not remove any safety rope or guard and in particular stay well clear of the ring entrance and exits.

If you see anything that common sense tells you is unsafe, report it to a Committee member or the organiser's tent.

Always take due care and attention to safety in order to make the Rally enjoyable for all.

Please keep DOGS ON A LEAD at all times.

### Overhead Electrical Cables - Considerations and Precautions

**Overview** - It has been noted that the areas the Heddington and Stockley Steam fair operate in have a number of 11Kv and 33Kv overhead power lines. Whilst these are not considered a significant risk in the spirit of continual improvement and improving safety wherever possible a number of minor changes have been discussed and agreed to increase volunteer, exhibitor and public safety. These changes include:

- not erecting any aerial, flagpole or temporary structure if a Marshall or Steward explicitly requests that you do not.
- not moving your vehicle once you have been given an area to locate in, if you need to move contact a marshal for advice.
- not interfering with or moving barriers erected for your safety.

### General

The Entrance Gate to the Rally Site will be manned from 9.00am to 10pm on Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> July and from 8.00am on Saturday and on Sunday 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> July. There will be no exceptions to this.
